

The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, April 30, 2015 at 6:00 P.M. at the Courthouse Annex Building for a called (advertised) meeting with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard present for the meeting. Staff present was Latrice Wilson, County Clerk. Others present were Brent Rucker, Road Superintendent, Sheriff Andy Hester and Mary Lee Green, Clerk of Superior Court.

Chairman McCard called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Commissioner Hall gave the invocation.

Motion by Commissioner Hall seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to amend the agenda to add garbage service, motion passed with Commissioner Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Commissioners discussed roads that were considered "to wet" by Transwaste on April 29, 2015. There were fourteen roads listed as being "to wet." Brent Rucker, Road Superintendent, went out and examined each road and found nothing wrong. He also stated he talked with Turner County Bus Shop Supervisor and was told the buses did not have any problems getting down these roads. Commissioners agreed to sit down and start enforcing the contract and to start documenting each incident.

Commissioners discussed the FY 2015-2016 operating budget. Commissioners discussed the Clerk of Superior Court and Tax Commissioners proposed budgets.
