

The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, June 7, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Turner County Agricultural Center for the regular board meeting with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun and Denham present. Commissioners Hall and McCard were not present. Staff present were Horace Hudgins, County Manager and Latrice Wilson, County Clerk. Chairman Calhoun called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone at 6:00 p.m.
