

The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, August 30, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Turner County Agricultural Center for the monthly Work Session with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard present. Staff present were Horace Hudgins, County Manager, Latrice Wilson, County Clerk and John Holland, County Attorney. Chairman Calhoun called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Commissioner Hall gave the invocation.

Commissioners presented Proclamations to the 4-H Air Pistol Teams and congratulated them on their successful season.

Commissioners discussed the Canning Plant. Mr. Jeff McDaniel, School Superintendent, gave an update on the maintenance and operational cost for the Canning Plant. Mr. Daniel asked the Board to consider reimbursing 30% of the total costs to repair the Canning Plant. The total cost for these repairs was \$96,962.47.

Commissioners discussed closing Sconyers Road. Commissioner Hall expressed his concerns about closing the road and asked the Board to strongly consider other businesses in the area. Commissioner McCard expressed his concerns and directed County Manager, Horace Hudgins, to check on the water issue on the road and report back to the Board.

Commissioners discussed appointing a voting delegate for the business session at the 2016 ACCG Legislative Leadership Conference.

Commissioners discussed the Safety Discount Program which qualifies the County for safety discounts on its workers compensation and general liability insurance premiums.

The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
