

The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Turner County Agricultural Center for the regular board meeting with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard present for the meeting. Staff present was Horace Hudgins, Interim County Manager, Latrice Wilson, County Clerk and John Holland, County Attorney. Others present were Mark Robinson, Fire Chief/EMA Director, Ben Baker, Editor of the Wiregrass Farmer.

Motion by Commissioner Calhoun seconded by Commissioner Hall to approve Executive Session Minutes for Tuesday, February 28, 2017, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard voting in favor of the motion.
