

The Turner County Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, February 15, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Turner County Courthouse Annex Building for a Called “advertised” Meeting with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham, Hall and McCard present for the meeting. Staff present were Latrice Wilson, County Clerk and John Holland, County Attorney.
