Motion by Commissioner Calhoun seconded by Commissioner Burgess to adopt a policy for COVID-19 Pandemic for Turner County stating “If an employee contact or is exposed to or has to care for someone, the county will continue to pay that employee as we are doing now. Sick or annual leave time will not count against their normal accrued time”, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Burgess seconded by Commissioner Calhoun to adopt Turner County Planned Response to the Coronavirus Pandemic for County Employees, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham and McCard voting in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioners Denham seconded by Commissioner Burgess to have meetings as usual, motion passed with Commissioners Burgess, Calhoun, Denham and McCard voting in favor of the motion.
