Motion by Commissioner Whiddon seconded by Commissioner Denham to accept bid from Chosen First Cleaning Services LLC for Janitorial Cleaning, motion passed with Commissioners Calhoun, Denham, Weaver and Whiddon voting in favor of the motion.
